
Clovis Tobacco Retail License (TRL): Ensuring Best Tobacco Sale Practices

Clovis Tobacco Retail Landscape

89% of 80 tobacco retailers are within 1,000 feet of another retailer.²



When more tobacco retailers are in close proximity to each other, residents' health suffers and vouth are more likely to start smoking.³

2 out of 11 Clovis tobacco retailers sold tobacco to someone underage.¹

How does a TRL Work?

In May 2024, the City of Clovis passed an ordinance that will require tobacco stores to obtain a tobacco retail license (TRL). Requiring a TRL to sell tobacco is a simple yet powerful tool to keep youth from using tobacco. When stores are required to have a license, they are monitored more closely, and there are fewer illegal sales to minors.



Limiting the total number of tobacco stores in your community.



Require a minimum distance between retailers.



Limit retailers' proximity to areas populated by youth such as schools and parks.



Help tobacco retailers understand and comply with tobacco policy.
